Venue

Please note, due unexpected last minute problems originating from Estreya hotels BFRA had to cancel the contract with them and urgently look for alternative venue.

The new venue is hotel Kaliopa in Albena resort, Black Sea. https://albena.bg/kaliopa

Location

Albena resort is situated north of Varna city, about 35km driving distance from Varna airport.

Hotel Kaliopa is just about 100m from the beach.

Transfer

Albena resort provides transfer from/to Varna airport or from/to Varna bus/train stations upon request. Pricing is per vehicle. One way prices from/to Varna airport or Varna downtown respectively: 55/50 EUR (4-seat vehicle), 60/55 EUR (8-seat vehicle), 70/65 EUR (14-seat vehicle), 80/75 EUR (16 or 18-seat vehicle), There is additional fee 8 EUR per hour, if the vehicle has to wait in cases of flight/bus/train delays. The bigger the vehicle, the cheaper price per seat. Depending on requested transfers, we will try to arrange the best price per seat schedule.

Parking

For those teams and individuals, traveling by car, Albena resort provides 3 parking zone. Parking is paid, prices respectively 2.5, 5 or 10 EUR per day (single pass).

Accomodation:

Double or triple rooms (single room upon request) in hotel Kaliopa.

Competition grounds

All competition halls are situated in hotel Dobrudja, about 300m away from hotel Kaliopa.

BFRA apologizes for this inconvenience, but unfortunately most vacation hotels, including Kaliopa, do not have any event halls.

Board

Rules: The current official HST Rules.

Technical: Technical setup will comply with the standards as stated in the election procedure.

The use of own keyboards and/or headphones is not allowed.

Keyer connection: recommended plug is double banana, however there will be possibility to use several more popular plug types, including aligator clips.

Accommodation for additional stay prior / after the competition will be available at the following rates:
